My wife Maria and I are quite concerned about the recent spate of violent car jackings in the area.

As a USMC combat veteran, I understand and appreciate the recent court ruling that stipulates police aren't responsible for our safety. As such, I encourage everyone I meet to obtain a Concealed Firearm License and attend proper training.

I'm sure you're receiving a deluge of emails and calls on the matter and I'll probably attend an upcoming council meeting to discuss police activities.

My informal recommendations to you:

1. Support Concealed Firearm License measures
2. Police should support CFL training
3. Educate public on importance of alarms and cameras
4. Increase police patrol activity
5. Launch a bait car program
6. Encourage maximum sentences for convicted criminals
