Dear Palmetto Bay Resident or Business,

On Thursday, July 4, 2019, the Village of Palmetto Bay will be hosting a special event in commemoration of our nation's Independence Day. The festivities will include games, food and drink concessions, live music, rides, and of course, no 4th of July festivity would be complete without a spectacular fireworks display to complete the evening!

The Village will be closing several affected roads, for public safety reasons, and is making every reasonable effort to minimize negative impacts to our residents and businesses. Due to event set-up and other logistics, vehicle access and parking around Palmetto Bay Village Hall and its immediate surrounding area will be very limited beginning at 8am-midnight. Please see road closure information listed below.

- Franjo Road will be closed from SW 180th Street to Nicklaus Children's Palmetto Bay Outpatient & Urgent Care Center parking entrance
- E. Guava Street westbound access will not be permitted from S. Dixie Highway
- Parking lot at the Hagan Building will be barricaded at the Guava St, US1, and Franjo Street
- E. Hibiscus Street eastbound access will not be permitted from S. Dixie Highway
- SW 98 Avenue Road northbound access will not be permitted past E. Indigo Road
- All northbound traffic on Franjo Road will not be permitted past SW 180th Street– must turn east
- SW 94th Avenue will be closed for vehicular traffic
- The following streets will be barricaded at the junction with SW 94th Avenue
 - SW 176th Street
 - SW 177th Street
 - SW 178th Street
 - SW 178th Terrace
 - SW 179th Terrace
