[Sponsored by Council Person Shelley Stanczyk].		
13 14	WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay holds the fee simple title to park land known as Palmetto Bay Park; and,		
15 16	WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay in compliance with its Parks Master Plan has built its first softball fields, that supports girls softball; and,		
17 18	WHEREAS, the fields can be multi-use, therefore accommodating either baseball or softball (for certain age groups); and,		
19 20	WHEREAS, as the demand is great for even more fields in the entire community, actually the demand is great for all types of recreational fields, of good quality; and,		
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to safeguard the use of the softball fields for primarily girls, in compliance with the Parks Master Plan, in order to ensure that the fields are not pre-booked or taken over by the great number of boys' baseball or other sports programs within the County; and,		
25 26	WHEREAS, the softball facility is the only facility of its kind in the County - it can hold tournaments as there are sufficient fields to do so unlike other areas of the County; and,		
27 28 29	WHEREAS, there is a disparate need and lack of availability of sports programs and locations for providing programs for girls/women within the Village, Miami-Dade County and the State; and,		
30 31 32	WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village Council to create a preference at Palmetto Bay Park for girls softball activities, where other facilities are provided in other parks for boys' baseball and other sports; and,		
33 34 35 36	WHEREAS, the Village has contacted the Office of Information and Recreation Services Department of Environmental Protection, to confirm that the Village would not be in violation of any grant agreement with the state relating to FRDAP funds used in the park, as the Village would "not discriminating based on sex but rather creating an opportunity for fairness": and		

1 2 3 4	WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council desire to specifically affirm its Park Master Plan design to maintain the primary use of Palmetto Bay Park field for girls' softball use, having girls use be the right of first refusal at the park; and to amend the Parks Master Plan relating to this use via a four/fifth (4/5) vote of the Village Council.		
5 6 7 8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:		
9 10	Section 1. The above whereas clauses are incorporated by reference into this resolution.		
11 12 13 14	Section 2. A 4/5ths vote of the Village Council would be required to change the Parks Master Plan as it relates to the use of the fields at Palmetto Bay Park by girls softball groups. A copy of this resolution shall be attached to the Parks Master Plan.		
15	Section 3. Any substantive change to the Parks Master Plan and this resolution shall		
16 17	require a 4/5ths vote of the Village Council and this resolution.		
18	Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
