Dear Mr. Kreisher:

This email is to acknowledge that the Village Clerk's office is in receipt of your request for 1) a copy of the Sacyr Franjo Project contract with amendments (change orders authorized/pending) and 2) provide the "amount already paid currently" to Sacyr Construction for the Franjo Project.

Your request has been logged as Public Records Request **2020-074** and will be submitted to Village Administration. As soon as the information is received, the Village Clerk's office will contact you.

Florida law states that an agency must respond within a "limited reasonable time." This is the time it takes to review the request, search, retrieve and process records for release. Some requests may only take a few minutes while others may take weeks. The length of time it takes largely depends on activity, volume and scope, but the City is committed to providing requested records as quickly and efficiently as possible. Florida Statute 119.01, referred to as the Florida Sunshine Law, governs the public's right to inspect and obtain copies of public records. The Office of the Attorney General's Government-In-The-Sunshine Manual contains additional helpful information, including summaries of what exemptions apply to public records requests. Anyone can request a public record in person, verbally over the telephone, in an email, or in writing. You do not have to give your name or explain why you are making a request. The Village of Palmetto Bay will provide all documents in the format in which we have them. We are not required to create documents in response to Public Records requests. Good morning Mr. Kreisher:

In response to your email dated February 24, 2020, please note that speaking with an individual and/or asking questions of a staff member or consultant is not considered a public records request pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 119 of the Florida Public Records Law; however, I have forwarded a copy of your list of questions to Village Administration. Village Administration has the knowledge of the Franjo Road project and the subject matter is not within the Village Clerk's purview.

The public records law relates to reviewing recorded and existing records. As the Village's records custodian, I am unable to answer your questions on the matter because your request does not relate to a public record, instead it relates to questions.

I apologize if I am unable to assist you on this matter, but best assure if you are in need of an existing record, we will log and process your public records request. If that is the case, please reply to this email indicating the record and/or types of records you are in search for and we would be happy to assist you.
