Please do not open the parks up yet. It should be considered by the Council that the actual number of cases is actually increasing, not decreasing, and we would not be following expert medical advice by opening them up now.

How do you plan to monitor all park users to make sure that they are following the rules? Do you really think that scofflaws are going to heed the warnings of parks' personnel to adhere to the rules? How much trouble do you think they will have with those that choose to ignore the warnings? Are the police going to be called into the park to remove these people not following the rules?

How many hours are the parks going to be open? We do not have enough parks' personnel to monitor over 60 acres (between the 2 large parks) 12 hours a day. How will you pay for the extra shifts needed?

Also, most importantly, you will place the parks' personnel in a very bad position to have to "police" the parks goers. If you have seen many videos of people allowed into facilities previously closed, you will see how many are flouting the rules. Do you want to put the lives at risk of those who follow the rules, but are imperiled by those that do not?

Also, is Cutler Bay planning to open their parks? If not, then we will be inundated far beyond our capacity to enforce safe distancing and mask wearing--even if they do, we do not have to blindly follow any other city..

I know that one woman who wrote to you previously said she wanted the parks open but would NOT wear a mask. What do you do about people like her who don't care who they might infect? Remember, most people do NOT know if they carry this virus prior to an outbreak, and they put others around them in danger if minimal rules are not followed.

Again, please keep the parks closed until we have better information on the virus.
