RESOLUTION NO. 2016-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE DECEMBER 10, 2016, PALMETTO BAY CANAL ASSOCIATION CANNED FOOD DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR OFFICIAL SPONSORSHIP AND PARTICIPATION AND TRANSMITTAL TO INTERESTED PARTIES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Eugene Flinn)

WHEREAS, Palmetto Bay cares and has a history of supporting worthwhile causes that benefit our community, both in and nearby/adjacent to our municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Palmetto Bay Canal Association is holding its 7th annual Boat Parade and Canned food Drive (see attached event promotional flyer as *‘Exhibit A’*); and

WHEREAS, Palmetto Bay typically participates in Holiday charitable events, specifically including Canned Food Drives; and

WHEREAS, this event, as presented annual by Noel and Rainer Schael, is a meritorious event, deserving of participation of our village residents and officially though the village of Palmetto Bay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village of Palmetto Bay supports both the concept as well as the participation in the Palmetto Bay Canal Association is holding its 7th annual Boat Parade and Canned food Drive, scheduled on December 10, 2016, in areas of the Village of Palmetto Bay.

Section 2. The Village authorizes the Village Manager to take all action required to facilitate Palmetto Bay’s sponsorship and participation in this event, including, but not necessarily limited to the following action:

A. Provide/allow the use of the Village Municipal Center as a designated drop off point for canned food, consistent with prior years.

B. Provide authorization for use of Coral Reef Park, after sunset, for as long as reasonably required, as a staging area for the 7th Annual Boat Parade.

C. Provide authorization for use of the official Village seal/logo for this event, listing Palmetto Bay as an official sponsor.




1 business hours or to any co-sponsoring schools during business hours up until the day prior to




Saturday, Dec. 10, 2016 @ 5:30pm
