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RESOLUTION NO. 2017-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS; APPROVING THE SELECTION OF WILLIAMS PAVING COMPANY TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PERMANENT ASPHALTIC SPEED TABLES ON SW 90TH AVENUE BETWEEN SW 170TH AND SW 172ND TERRACE; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPROVE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$12,500 FOR PERMANENT TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES THAT WILL SUBSTANTIALLY IMPROVE THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Vice Mayor John DuBois)

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay continues to be committed to the safety and livability of its residential neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2015-61 was approved by Council for the purchase and installation of traffic calming devices in the form of temporary speed humps for placement on local streets on an as-needed, case-by-case basis; and

WHEREAS, Temporary speed humps were placed on SW 90th AV between SW 170th St and SW 172nd Terrace for a period of 90 days effective November 11, 2016 through February 17, 2017; and

WHEREAS, removal of the temporary speed humps on this neighborhood roadway has once again resulted in excessive traffic volumes and speeding; and

WHEREAS, Installation of permanent speed tables will immediately discourage speeding of vehicles during peak hours on SW 90TH Avenue between SW 170th Street and SW 172nd Terrace; and

WHEREAS, Administration requested and received proposals and pricing from three contractors for construction of asphaltic speed tables at various locations throughout the Village of Palmetto Bay, with the lowest most responsive proposal received from Williams Paving Company for an amount of \$5,985.00 per speed table installed; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A details the locations and number of speed tables planned for immediate installation; and

WHEREAS, funding for installation of permanent speed tables in these neighborhood for an amount not to exceed \$12,500 is within the current fiscal year's budget for Neighborhood Traffic Calming Improvements, and

1 **WHEREAS**, upon Village Council approval, Williams Paving Company will install
2 permanent speed tables at the locations identified in Exhibit A in compliance with Village of
3 Palmetto Bay Traffic Calming Procedures.


8 **Section 1.** The Village Council hereby approves the selection of Williams Paving Company to
9 construct speed tables on SW 90TH Avenue between SW 170th Street and SW 172nd Terrace for an
10 amount of \$5,985.00 per speed table with a total project cost not to exceed \$12,500.

12 **Section 2.** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Williams
13 Paving Company for construction of speed tables for a contract amount not to exceed \$12,500,
14 and execute related documentation on behalf of the Village once approved as to final form,
15 content and legal sufficiency by the Village Attorney.

17 **Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
