A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE ‘SAFE CITIES, SAFE FLORIDA’ INITIATIVE THROUGH THE FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES, INC. DURING FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Councilmember Karyn Cunningham)

WHEREAS, Florida’s municipalities provide extensive services to citizens, residents and visitors each day and these services cover many aspects of the public’s health, safety, and welfare; and
