12 **IMPLEMENT TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS AS SOON AS**
13 **POSSIBLE, INCLUDING OBTAINING APPROVAL FROM**
14 **MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN**
15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** *(Sponsored by Mayor Eugene Flinn,*

17 *Cunningham, Councilmember David Singer, and*
18 *Councilmember Larissa Siegel Lara)*

20 **WHEREAS,** the roads mentioned were designed and built prior to
21 the Village’s incorporation, and are not designed as complete streets;
22 and

24 **WHEREAS,** these roads lack sidewalks and sufficient width to
25 safely carry the vehicle load that is currently being experienced daily;
26 and

28 **WHEREAS,** the excess traffic experienced has caused serious
29 deterioration to the quality of life of the surrounding communities; and

31 **WHEREAS,** the need for traffic modifications in these areas has
32 been established and continuing work must be undertaken to achieve
33 approval from Miami-Dade County.

35 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND**
36 **THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY,**



40 **Implement Traffic Improvements.** The Village Manager is authorized
41 to initiate preliminary negotiations for approval from the County for


1 implementation of traffic calming, pricing, and timeline for the area on
2 Farmers Road from Old Cutler Road to SW 136th Street and the area of
3 Old Cutler Road and SW 136th Street.

5 **Section 2. Directive to Implement Traffic improvements as**
6 **Soon as Possible.** The Village Manager is hereby directed to
7 implement traffic improvements as soon as possible for the area of
8 Farmers Road from Old Cutler South to SW 136th Street and the area of
9 Old Cutler Road and SW 136th Street; specifically, to work to obtain
10 Miami-Dade County approval for the traffic calming, pricing, timeline
11 needed.



Re: Traffic blockage on Old Cutler Road and
SW 136 street

PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION:

The purpose of this memo is to require Miami Dade County to remove the temporary blockade on Old Cutler Road westbound onto SW 136th Street.

MAJOR POINTS/REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION:

A pilot program was installed by the County at this intersection and they have since then indicated that this will become permanent, however that hasn't happened, and this intersection looks unsightly. We request the County to review the closure of this intersection and if they are to continue with the decision to permanently close it, we request they do so and bring this intersection up to our community standards. If the County is waiting for the redesign of SW 136th Street to improve this intersection we humbly request that a left turn lane be part of the solution to help west bound traffic and provide a better travel access for fire safety equipment.

PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE OF THE COST OF IMPLEMENTATION:

Costs for the approval of this item are to be borne by Miami Dade County.

SOURCE OF FUNDS TO PAY SUCH COSTS:
