13 **PERMANENT SOLUTIONS AT ONCE OR AS AN**
14 **ALTERNATIVE ALLOW THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO**
15 **BAY TO IMPLEMENT PERMANENT SOLUTIONS**
16 **THROUGH A JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT;**
17 **PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** *(Sponsored by*
18 *Councilmember Karyn Cunningham)*

20 **WHEREAS,** a pilot program was previously installed by Miami-
21 Dade County at the intersection of SW 136th Street and Old Cutler Road,
22 to limit westbound vehicular access onto SW 136th Street from Old Cutler
23 Road; and,
24

25 **WHEREAS,** this pilot program has added to the westbound traffic
26 loads onto Farmers Road; and,
27

28 **WHEREAS,** the quality of life on a road not designated to be a
29 collector road are far exceeded; and,

31 **WHEREAS,** the Village Council desire to petition Miami-Dade
32 County to immediately implement permanent solutions for this unsafe
33 intersection OR as an alternative, allow the Village of Palmetto Bay to
34 implement the solutions through a Joint Participation Agreement.

36 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND**
37 **THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY,**
38 **FLORIDA,**

40 **Section 1.** The Mayor and Council of the Village of Palmetto Bay
41 hereby petition Miami-Dade County to review existing traffic conditions at

1 the intersection of Farmers Road and Old Cutler Road and make a final
2 determination on the most appropriate permanent solution to improve the
3 safety at the intersection and reduce westward movement from Old
4 Cutler Road.

5
6 **Section 2.** The Mayor & Village Council further request that
7 Miami-Dade County implement the permanent solutions immediately
8 providing relief from the daily vehicular loads this roadway endures.

9
10 **Section 3.** The Mayor & Village Council further request that
11 Miami-Dade County implement the permanent solutions immediately, or
12 as an alternative, allow the Village of Palmetto Bay to implement the
13 permanent solutions through a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with
14 Miami-Dade County. If the latter is accepted by Miami-Dade County, the
15 Village Manager shall bring the JPA and associated costs before the
16 Village Council for approval.



Re: Traffic calming as per map – area
North of SW 144th. Street and Farmers
Road

PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION:

The purpose of this memo is to require Administration to develop a Resolution requiring a proposal for traffic calming, pricing, timeline and formal application to the County for approval as indicated in the embedded map – covering generally, the area north of 144th Street, on Farmers Road.

MAJOR POINTS/REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION:

Approval of this proposed action will enact a Resolution to help calm traffic on roads not designed as complete streets. This has caused a serious deterioration to the quality of life standards of this community. This area was designed and built prior to the Village's incorporation; without sidewalks and without sufficient width to safely carry the vehicle load that is currently projected. Additionally, it is creating an extreme safety hazard for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. Miami-Dade County has failed to provide for traffic mobility in the County and is seeking methods to relieve the traffic congestion by using local roads that are not designed to carry this additional capacity and at the detriment to the residents and against the wishes of the municipality. Additionally, this area has seen a marked increase in traffic after the County implemented a no left turn from Old Cutler road to SW 136th Street and it currently qualifies for street calming. Through this Resolution, we are also requesting Commissioner Daniela Levine Cava to help us obtain approval for this area from County agencies.


PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE OF THE COST OF IMPLEMENTATION:
