

RESOLUTION NO. 04-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO A POSSIBLE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BOND ISSUE; EXPRESSING THE POSITION OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY THAT THE BOND ISSUE SHOULD INCLUDE: A) A MUNICIPAL SET-ASIDE SIMILAR TO THE PEOPLES TRANSPORTATION TAX REFERENDUM AND A PARK PROGRAM THAT WOULD INCLUDE MUNICIPAL PROJECTS SIMILAR TO THE SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS BOND PROGRAM; OR ALTERNATELY B) SPECIFIC VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY PROJECTS; AND C) CRITICAL COUNTYWIDE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS SPECIFICALLY INCLUDING: i) THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT REQUEST FOR PERRINE-CUTLER RIDGE WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS ii) A POTABLE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM FOR AREAS THREATENED BY SALTWATER INTRUSION AND iii) IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DEERING ESTATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Bonds for the Decade of Progress will be retired in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is soliciting projects for inclusion in a new reauthorized bond issue; and

WHEREAS, it is important for the Village of Palmetto Bay to formally advise the County of those programs and projects the Village recommends for inclusion; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of these programs and projects would be of significant benefit to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is the expressed position of the Village of Palmetto Bay that the Bond Issue should include: A) a municipal set-aside similar to the Peoples Transportation Tax Referendum and a Park Program that would include municipal projects similar to the Sage Neighborhood Parks Bond Program; or alternately B) specific Village of Palmetto Bay projects including:

- Perrine Park – Acquisition of 7 Acres - \$900,000
- Perrine Park – Acquisition of 5 Acres - \$1,400,000

- Perrine Park – Improvements - \$5,000,000
- Bayfront Park – Improvements - \$4,000,000
- Coral Reef Park – Improvements - \$4,000,000
- Public Park – Improvements - \$300,000
- Perrine Wayside Park – Acquisition and Improvements - \$1,500,000
- Palmetto Bay Village Center Park – Acquisition and Improvements - \$2,000,000
- Old Cutler Bike Path – Improvements - \$1,000,000
- C-100 Park – Improvements - \$2,000,000
- Street Signage – Improvements - \$1,250,000
- Entrance Signage – Improvements - \$500,000; and
- Village Hall Police Station/Civic Center – Acquisition & Construction - \$10,000,000


and (C) critical Countywide infrastructure projects specifically including:

- The Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department Request for Perrine Cutler Ridge Water and Sewer Improvements
- A potable water infrastructure program for areas threatened by saltwater intrusion; and
- Improvements to the Deering Estate

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect upon approval.
