A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO TREE PLANTING; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PURCHASE TREES FOR CANOPY REPLACEMENT THROUGHOUT THE VILLAGE FROM MELROSE NURSERY, INC., UNDER COUNTY BID #5066-2/03-2 IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$69,250; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay was severely impacted by Hurricane Katrina; and,

WHEREAS, the tree canopy throughout the Village sustained major damage and had to be removed; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to replace the lost tree canopy and initiate the tree planting project on the SW 94th Avenue swale.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County awarded contracts to Melrose Nursery and Vila & Sons, Inc. under Invitation to Bid No. 5066-2/03-2 to install new trees and the Village of Palmetto Bay wishes to piggyback off the Miami-Dade County contracts; and,

WHEREAS, the Village requested quotes from the referenced nurseries for the purchase and installation of new trees and Melrose Nursery, Inc. provided the lowest cost; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase 40- 18ft. Live Oaks and 20-12ft. Mahoganies for Coral Reef Park, 50-18' Live Oaks for SW 94th Avenue along the swale abutting Perrine Park, and 150- 12ft. Oaks for right-of-ways canopy replacement; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the proposal, the aggregate cost for the delivery, installation, bracing and initial watering of all trees is \$69,250.







Cassia, 10-12' ht @ \$ 225.00 ea
Mahogany tree, 11- 12' ht @ \$ 185.00 ea
Live Oak trees, 11-12' ht @ \$ 185.00 ea
Live Oak trees, 16-18' ht @ \$ 420.00 ea

Above cost would include delivery & installation, guying & bracing, all necessary planting soil & initial watering in.

Our proposal would not include removal of existing dead trees or removal of stumps prior to installation of new trees, removal of asphalt pavement or sidewalks or removal of construction debris.

You also indicated a need for 1 Sausage tree. We could provide & install 1 Sausage tree, 15 gal, 5' o.a. ht at a cost of \$ 150.00.

This appears to be the largest available Sausage tree in the South Florida area at this time.
