Re: Co-Designation of SW 162 Street
from SW 78 Avenue to SW 80
Avenue

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2012-73; CO-DESIGNATING SW 162 STREET BETWEEN SW 80 AVENUE AND SW 78 AVENUE IN HONOR OF KAELY CAMACHO; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS:

The process for co-designation of roadways in the Village is governed by Ordinance 05-12, which defines the types of requests and also mandates that any requests are considered in April.

In September of 2012, the Council voted to hear the request for co-designation from the family of Kaely Camacho and conducted a public hearing to approve Resolution 2012-73, copy of which is attached hereto.

Shortly after approval of Resolution 2012-73, the family contacted the Village and indicated that they wished to have the street changed to a location that would be more visible to school children, reminding all of the importance of not driving while intoxicated. While the matter was being considered, the installation of signage was placed on hold. The family has requested that the Village consider approving the co-designation for the road adjacent to the northern boundary of Southwood Middle School – SW 162 Street from SW 78 Avenue east to SW 80 Avenue. Staff contacted Principal Magda Pereira of Southwood Middle School and she indicated she has no objection to the co-designation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Six signs require modification. The cost per sign is \$90.00. Therefore, the fiscal impact for this effort is \$540.00.

RECOMMENDATION: Council discretion, following public hearing.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2012-73; CO-DESIGNATING SW 162 STREET BETWEEN SW 80 AVENUE AND SW 78 AVENUE IN HONOR OF KAELY CAMACHO; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2012, the Village Council held a public hearing; the result of the hearing was the co-designation of a roadway in Palmetto Bay in honor of Kaely Camacho, who tragically passed away on April 13, 2012, when a drunk driver struck the vehicle in which she was a passenger. The Council, following the public hearing, co-designated SW 181 Street between SW 92 Court and SW 91 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the ordinance, the village council may name a site after a person who has made significant contributions to the community, thereby furthering the Village's good name and image; and,

WHEREAS, although she was young girl, Kaely's achievements were remarkable. At school, Kaely was the Assistant Editor of the Yearbook, an Honor Roll Student, and a member of the National Junior Honor Society. For community service, Kaely was a volunteer for the Special Olympics in 2011, a regular volunteer at Christ Fellowship Church (where she was a member), and a Coral Reef Bronco's Cheerleader; and

WHEREAS, Kaely was not only loved by her friends, but demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities. She was exceptionally kind to all and in her memory, her family, friends and students at Southwood Middle School raised over \$21,000.00 for Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD); and

WHEREAS, the family wished to request Resolution 2013-73 be rescinded and signage be re-located to abut the northern end of Southwood Middle School from SW 162 Street between SW 78 Avenue and SW 80 Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution 2013-73 is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. Pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance number 05-12, the Village Council finds that a significant contribution has been made to the Village, and furthermore, the Council agrees that SW 162 Street between SW 80 Avenue east to SW 78 Avenue shall be, after public hearing and input, officially named **KAELY CAMACHO WAY**.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, CO-DESIGNATING SW 181 STREET BETWEEN SW 92 COURT AND SW 91 AVENUE IN HONOR OF KAELY CAMACHO; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, tragically, on Friday, April 13, 2012, Southwood Middle student Kaely Camacho passed away when a drunk driver struck the vehicle in which she was a passenger; and

WHEREAS, although she was young girl, Kaely's achievements were remarkable. At school, Kaely was the Assistant Editor of the Yearbook, an Honor Roll Student, and a member of the National Junior Honor Society. For community service, Kaely was a volunteer for the Special Olympics in 2011, a regular volunteer at Christ Fellowship Church (where she was a member), and a Coral Reef Bronco's Cheerleader; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2005, the Village Council adopted ordinance no 05-12 relating to naming, re-naming and co-designating village facilities, parks, etc.; and,

WHEREAS, the village may recognize a person, family or corporation, that has provided a contribution through volunteerism, leadership, financial contribution and/or other services considered extraordinary or long term in nature; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to co-designate SW 181 Street between SW 92 Court and SW 91 Avenue in honor of this wonderful young lady for her significant contributions to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
