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**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT FEES; ADOPTING THE 2013 PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT; REPEALING THE 2008-2009 PERMIT FEE SCHEDULES FOR BUILDING PERMITS; PROVIDING FOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; CODIFICATION; SEVERABILITY; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS:**

In 2008, the Village enacted 08-22, which provides the building, zoning and public works fee schedule for various applications and permit requests. In 2010-2011, the Village created the Building and Permitting Committee – which was comprised of a residential subcommittee and a business community subcommittee. Together, the two subcommittees created a final report, which report was accepted by the Village Council. One of the recommendations of the Committee was to create a new building fee schedule. Based upon that recommendation, the administration is presenting the proposed revised fee schedule, consistent with the recommendation of the Committee.

Enclosed is a matrix of the permitting fees charged by neighboring municipalities.

Staff is requesting one modification to be included for second reading. The request is to implement the new fee schedule 45 days after adoption, so that staff can effectively coordinate a seamless transition into the new fee schedule, update all computer programs, and properly notify the community and staff of the modifications.

**FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:**

The building department permit fees are consistent with the recommendation of the Committee and ultimately should be revenue neutral, as the fund is an enterprise fund, which requires that specific building fees be utilized not for supplementing the general revenue fund, but to be revenue neutral to the building department.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT FEES; ADOPTING THE 2013 PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT; REPEALING THE 2008-2009 PERMIT FEE SCHEDULES FOR BUILDING PERMITS; PROVIDING FOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; CODIFICATION; SEVERABILITY; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay is authorized by state law to charge fees for the issuance of building permits and to recoup costs associated with the processing of applications for building permit plan reviews and inspections by the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Village is entitled to amend its permitting fee schedule; and,

WHEREAS, the Village pursuant to Ordinance no. 08-22, adopted on November 3, 2008, its 2009 Permit Fee Schedule; and,

WHEREAS, the Village, pursuant to section 4.3(A)(5) of the Village Charter, may set service or user charges for municipal services or grant administrative authority to set such charges;

WHEREAS, the Village has updated its permit fee schedule to include all aspects of permitting including building, zoning, and public works permitting requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the Building and Permitting Committee as a part of their final report recommended a simplified fee schedule that the Village Council desires to implement; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to adopt the 2013 permit fee schedule, which schedule addresses the financial concerns of the Village relating to increased costs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Village Council hereby enacts the Village's 2013 Permitting Fee Schedule for the issuance of building, , provisions of inspections, issuance of certificates of occupancy, and related building activities and services which fee schedule is attached hereto as Schedule "A". The remainder of the existing fee schedule is to remain in place.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be codified and included in the Code of Ordinances.

**Section 3.** If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Section 4.** Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be

invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

**Section 5.** Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. To the extent any provisions of the Code conflict with this ordinance, in particular Ordinance 08-22, those provisions are repealed in its entirety. The remainder of the items shall remain in enforcement.

**Section 6.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective 45 days after upon adoption.

**Section 7.** This ordinance shall be codified and included in the Code of Ordinances.
