II. New Business:

- New mural proposals for Coral Reef handball courts. Village Manager, Silva suggests AIPP make a call for proposals.
- Village Manager, Silva requests that AIPP come up with a pattern for all crosswalks with the goal of making Palmetto Bay distinctive; references Shaw, a community in St. Louis
 - Dana suggests that is Public Works project and should come from Public Works budget and wonders about interfacing with the FDOT?
 - What are ADA requirements?
- Mayor Flynn wants to see bike repair accommodations along the Chinese Bridge bike path
- Village Manager, Silva: revamp the way we make our artist calls; current RFQs too limiting
 - AIPP board agrees and really wants to remove any discussion of historic significance as that limits the creativity of artists.
- Art in the Park. Howard Fein running currently at Coral Reef Park on May 21/22, 2016.
 - 2017: want it be juried
 - AIPP to be able to make suggestions for judges for 2017
 - Village Manager, Silva suggests art show and Farmers' Market but AIPP board members remind him that the funds do not cover those events. Dana suggests applying for a Miami-Dade County Dept. of Cultural Affairs Community Grant.
- Veterans Park is getting off the ground
 - Discussion for developing a sensory garden with possible free notes (musical instruments)
- Burger King property being donated for parks; includes 22 acres along Old Cutler and 30 acres of mangrove shoreline
 - March 7 – going for ordinance
- Other park options that were mentioned:
 - across from Perrine Elementary; \$1/year lease in perpetuity for passive park
 - Coral Reef, east side of the canal; has a rubberized walk way
- School Art Show – year 2 at Thallata Estate. Schools being considered for participation are:

- Perrine
- Southwood
- Howard Drive
