Public art is artwork in the public realm, regardless of whether it is situated on public or private property, or whether it is acquired through public or private funding.

Public art can be a sculpture, mural, paving pattern, lighting, seating, building facade, kiosk, gate, fountain, play equipment, engraving, carving, fresco, mobile, collage, mosaic, bas-relief, tapestry, photograph, drawing, or earthwork.


