

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PROCUREMENT; DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO IDENTIFY AVAILABLE PROVIDERS OF MUNICIPAL RADIO STATIONS IN ORDER FOR THE VILLAGE COUNCIL TO CONSIDER THE OPTION OF ESTABLISHING A RADIO STATION TO SERVE THE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to investigate the possibility of providing a radio station within the Village of Palmetto Bay for the purpose of disseminating important information to visitors and residents of Palmetto Bay, particularly during times of crisis when other methods of communication, i.e., television and computers, may not be accessible; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.10, of the Village Charter mandates clearly drawn specifications and competitive procurement; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article VI, Division 2 of the Village's Code of Ordinance contains the provisions of procurement that are applicable to all village contracts and purchases; and,

WHEREAS, the Procurement Code of the Village assigns the responsibility of purchasing agent to the Village Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Manager is directed to identify available providers so that the Council may consider the option of establishing a radio station to serve the residents of Palmetto Bay.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
