RESOLUTION NO. 2011-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CANAL EROSION; REQUESTING THE STATE TO FUND AND UNDERTAKE THE RESTORATION AND PERMANENT HARDENING OF CANALS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Shelley Stanczyk)

WHEREAS, in December of 2008, the Council passed Resolution 08-119 that urged the State of Florida to fund and permanently restore the eroded canals within the Village of Palmetto Bay; and

WHEREAS, many property owners throughout Palmetto Bay own homes along the various C100 canals that are continuing to experience significant erosion of the canal banks that border their property; and

WHEREAS, the deterioration is worsening and will continue to worsen without permanent hardening being performed; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council urge the Florida House and Senate, and Governor Rick Scott to take action on this matter by funding and commencing restoration of the C100 canal banks throughout Palmetto Bay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above whereas clauses are incorporated by reference into this resolution.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Florida House, Florida Senate, Governor Rick Scott, and to the Director of the South Florida Water Management District.


