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RESOLUTION NO. 2012-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, URGING THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO LOCATE AND PERMIT SIGNAGE FOR THE BENEFIT OF LOCAL COMMUNITY/SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Shelley Stanczyk)

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation remains responsible for installation and location of signage in the right-of-way along the US-1 commercial corridor within the municipal limits of Palmetto Bay; and

WHEREAS, for many years, local community/service organizations had two locations along the right-of-way in the center island of the US-1 corridor wherein signage was attached to chain link fencing. The signage announced the organizations' presence and also announced their meetings; and

WHEREAS, recently, the signage was removed by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the local community/service organizations have requested that signage again be erected to announce their presence; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to express their support and urge FDOT to permit the signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby expresses its support for local community/service organizations.

Section 2. The Village Council urges the Florida Department of Transportation to work with the organizations to locate and permit signage for the benefit of the organizations within the US-1 median commercial corridor within Palmetto Bay limits.

Section 3. The Village Clerk shall transmit a copy of this resolution to the State of Florida Department of Transportation.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
