RESOLUTION NO. 2013-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES (AIPP) BOARD, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY AIPP BOARD; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, through adoption of Ordinance 07-05, the Village of Palmetto Bay created the Arts in Public Places (AIPP) Board, as a component of the Art in Public Places program. The Art in Public Places Program was designed to promote the general welfare by encouraging pride in the community, increasing property values, enhancing the quality of life through artistic opportunities, uniting the community through shared cultural experiences, and creating a cultural legacy for future generations through the collection and exhibition of high-quality art pieces. The Arts Advisory Board, through coordination with the Village's Planning & Zoning Department, is tasked with the responsibility of overseeing the public education and curatorial aspects of the program; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-05 further defined and modified Ordinance 07-05 and, in addition to other important revisions, allows for four-year terms for Arts in Public Places Board members, which is appropriate due to the specific expert qualifications required of this Board. However, in order to allow for mandated staggered terms, three members shall serve for an initial two year term, and two shall serve for four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:





Dana Pezoldt (2-year appointment) (Councilwoman Lindsay)


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
