

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES (AIPP) BOARD, APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY AIPP BOARD; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2007, the Village of Palmetto Bay created the Arts in Public Places Board, to assist with the Art in Public Places program. The Art in Public Places Program was designed to promote the general welfare by encouraging pride in the community, increasing property values, enhancing the quality of life through artistic opportunities, uniting the community through shared cultural experiences, and creating a cultural legacy for future generations through the collection and exhibition of high-quality art pieces. The Arts Advisory Board, through coordination with the Village's Planning & Zoning Department, is tasked with the responsibility of overseeing the public education and curatorial aspects of the program; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two vacancies on this Board; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous to appoint a full Board in order to allow the Board to fulfill its responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following individuals are appointed:


Jamie Wasser (4-year appointment) (Appointed by Mayor Eugene Flinn)
