SUMMARY OF CURRENT SITUATION AND ACTIONS

NEW AREA OF LOCAL ZIKA VIRUS TRANSMISSION IN MIAMI-DADE

- On October 13th, the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) confirmed local transmission of Zika occurring in a new small area in Miami-Dade County. The street boundaries are NW 79th Street to the North, NW 63rd Street to the South, NW 10th Avenue to the West and North Miami Avenue to the East. This area is about one square mile. *Please see attached map showing new area of local transmission.*

FLORIDA HEALTH IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

- FDOH Zika testing for pregnant moms available at the following locations Monday - Friday (8:30am-3:00pm)
 - Health District Center, 1350 NW 14 Street, Miami, FL 33125
 - West Perrine Health Clinic, 18255 Homestead Ave. Miami, FL 33157
- A total of **924** pregnant women have been tested for Zika at FDOH's Health District Center and West Perrine Health Clinic.
- Pregnant women can contact FDOH's Epidemiology Division (305) 324-2400 to obtain Zika prevention kits.
- The Florida State Surgeon General and Secretary of Health have established a Zika hotline (855-622-6735) and are issuing status reports Monday – Friday on CDC-confirmed Zika cases by county.


PUBLIC WORKS - TREATMENT OF DRAINS WITH DUNKINS

- County crews have begun their second round of storm drain treatments, as of October 14th 2016, County crews have treated **45,843** drains with BTI tablets in Miami-Dade County.



MOSQUITO CONTROL SERVICE REQUESTS (SR)




