**FLORIDA HEALTH IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY**


- FDOH Zika testing for pregnant moms available Monday - Friday (8:30am-3:00pm) at:


- Drain and Cover posters available for pick-up. Please email: [dswm@miamidadegov](mailto:dswm@miamidadegov)


**MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ZIKA CASES**

**ZIKA TRANSMISSION AREAS**

**LITTLE RIVER**

- October 13<sup>th</sup>: FDOH confirmed local transmission of Zika occurring in a small area in Miami-Dade County. The street boundaries are NW 79<sup>th</sup> Street to the North, NW 63<sup>rd</sup> Street to the South, NW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the West and North Miami Avenue to the East. This area is about one square mile.

**MIAMI BEACH**

- September 16<sup>th</sup>: FDOH expanded the Miami Beach local area of transmission to a 4.5 square-mile area from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 63<sup>rd</sup> Street due to additional confirmed cases beyond the 1.5 square-mile area of 8<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> Street.
