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ORDINANCE NO. 2016-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, OF MIAMI-DADE FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2016, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser ("Property Appraiser") has certified the gross taxable value as \$2,659,717,359 within the Village of Palmetto Bay for the year 2016 which includes all real and personal property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2016, the village Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-55 determining the proposed maximum millage rate of 2.4470 for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2016 and further scheduling two public hearings on the millage rate as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, to be held on Monday, September 12, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. and on Monday, September 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., at the Village of Palmetto Bay Municipal Center, 9705 E hibiscus Street, Palmetto Bay, FL 33157; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council and the Village Manager have reviewed the proposed Fiscal Year 2016-2017 budget for the Village and have considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures contemplated for in the budget and have determined that the levy set forth below provides the necessary funds for such expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Fiscal Year 2016-2017 final millage rate for the Village of Palmetto Bay is 2.3292 mills, which is equal to the rolled back rate of 2.3292.

Section 3. The Tax Collector is hereby directed to proceed with the collection and enforcement of the taxes levied herein as authorized by law.

Section 4. The Village Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Ordinance to the County Property Appraiser; the County Tax Collector and Department of Revenue within three days of adoption of final budget hearing.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.

1 **Section 6.** If any section, clause, sentences, or phrase of this ordinance is for any
2 reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding shall not
3 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
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
5 **Section 7.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
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
