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3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
4 VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, OF MIAMI-DADE FLORIDA,
5 ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE OF THE VILLAGE
6 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2013,
7 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065,
8 FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR
9 CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING
10 FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Miami-Dade County Property
12 Appraiser ("Property Appraiser") has certified the gross taxable value as \$2,400,102,401 within the
13 Village of Palmetto Bay for the year 2013 which includes all real property within the Village; and,
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15 WHEREAS, on July 11, 2013, the Village Council adopted Resolution No. 2013-57
16 determining the proposed maximum millage rate of 2.4470 for the fiscal year commencing October 1,
17 2013 and further scheduling two public hearings on the millage rate as required by Section 200.065,
18 Florida Statutes, to be held on Monday, September 9, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, September
19 18, 2013 at 7:00 p.m., at the Village of Palmetto Bay Municipal Center, 9705 E hibiscus Street, Palmetto
20 Bay, FL 33157; and,
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22 WHEREAS, the Village Council and the Village Manager have reviewed the proposed Fiscal
23 Year 2013-2014 budget for the Village and have considered an estimate of the necessary expenditures
24 contemplated for in the budget and have determined that the levy set forth below provides the
25 necessary funds for such expenditures.
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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE
28 COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY,
29 FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

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31 **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
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33 **Section 2.** The Fiscal Year 2013-2014 operating millage rate for the Village of Palmetto
34 Bay is 2.4470 mills, which is 1.76% greater than the rolled back rate of 2.4047 mills.
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36 **Section 3.** The Tax Collector is hereby directed to proceed with the collection and
37 enforcement of the taxes levied herein as authorized by law.
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39 **Section 4.** The Village Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Ordinance to the County
40 Property Appraiser; the County Tax Collector and Department of Revenue within three days of
41 adoption of final budget hearing.
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43 **Section 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this
44 ordinance are repealed.
