Palmetto Bay Joins with County Officials to Unveil ‘Deering Estate Way’ Signage

*Ceremony commemorates co-designation of signage at SW 168 St.
and SW 72 Ave.; underscores Deering Estate’s good-neighbor status*

PALMETTO BAY, Fla., June 22, 2010 – All signs point to the strong relationship that exists between the Village of Palmetto Bay and its good neighbors at the Deering Estate at Cutler – a fact that will be underscored during a ceremony, Wednesday at 10 a.m., at which new “Deering Estate Way” street signage will be unveiled.

“The Deering Estate is an important landmark in the Miami-Dade County park system that is well used and much loved by the residents of Palmetto Bay,” said Mayor Eugene Flinn. “There is no better way to signify our relationship than by co-designating the street sign for all to see directly in front of the Deering Visitor Center.”

The Resolution for the addition of the “Deering Estate Way” signage was brought forward by Palmetto Bay Councilman Howard J. Tendrich, and unanimously approved by the Village Council on April 12.

Palmetto Bay and Miami-Dade County officials invite the public to attend an unveiling of the new co-designated sign at the intersection of SW 72 Ave. and SW 168 St. in Palmetto Bay. The name “Deering Estate Way” stems from the historic property, the Deering Estate at Cutler, located at 16701 SW 72 Avenue. The Deering Estate at Cutler is very pleased that the Palmetto Bay Village Council has chosen to honor the Deering Estate by co-designating SW 168th Street in this way.

The Deering Estate, located at 16701 SW 72 Ave., is a 444-acre natural and archeological preserve and historic site is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It serves as a center for education, culture, and recreation, with historic house tours offered daily.
