

**SUMMARY OF CURRENT SITUATION AND ACTIONS**

1. An area of low pressure associated with a tropical wave is near the Turks and Caicos with sustained winds of 25-30 mph. Shear over the system and dry air to the west is expected to lessen over the next day or two as the system moves into a more conducive environment for development across the Bahamas. Forecast confidence remains low with regards to intensity but confidence continues to increase in a general track towards the WNW as it approaches Florida anytime between Saturday night and Monday.
2. Regardless of the disturbance's development, or lack thereof, there are increasing chances of rain and flooding over the next several days. Five day rain totals could be 4-8 inches, with possible higher amounts in localized areas.
3. SFWMD began drawdown of the coastal structures last night. The internal drawdown will begin later today. Canals are within normal limits.
4. EOC Partners have been notified and briefed on the contingency plans and/or placed on standby.
5. The Miami-Dade EOC has created a WebEOC ® incident called *Invest 99L*.
