


**SUMMARY OF CURRENT SITUATION AND ACTIONS**

1. Upper-level winds are expected to remain unfavorable for significant development of *Invest 99L* during the next couple of days while the system moves west-northwestward at about 10 mph. Environmental conditions could become a little more conducive for development early next week when the system moves into the eastern Gulf of Mexico. The Air Force Reserve Hurricane Hunter aircraft scheduled to investigate this system this morning has been canceled.
2. The NWS forecast for today calls for a 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms, decreasing to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms this afternoon and into tonight. As much as 2 inches of rain is possible and as much as 5 inches over the next several days, with higher amounts possible in localized areas.
3. SFWMD canals are within normal limits.
4. Mayor Gimenez will be conducting a press briefing this afternoon.
5. The Miami-Dade EOC will remain at Level 3 to continue monitoring *Invest 99L* and associated weather for potential impacts on Miami-Dade County.
