Dear Applicant:

Per section 30-90.24 of the land development code entitled " *Special Event Signs*" an individual property owner or business owner is allowed one banner not to exceed 3' x 10' or other temporary sign not exceeding said dimensions per site in all commercial and mix-used districts.

The banner or sign may be two sided. The maximum duration for a special event banner displayed shall be 30 days max. All banners shall otherwise comply with the criteria of section 30-90 of the land development code as it relates to the types of permitted and prohibited signs.

Within a residential district a special event banner may not be held for a commercial purpose; not-for-profit purposes are allowed.
