Project Purpose:

Installation of a traffic table will reduce high vehicular speeds and provide for sufficient intersection capacity to comfortably allow for additional vehicular growth without negatively impacting operations and safety.

Project Boundary:


Intersection of SW 168th Street and SW 87th Avenue

Project Improvements:

The Village of Palmetto Bay will commence to the construction of a Traffic Calming Device at the intersection of SW 168th Street and SW 87th Avenue. The project is to include the reconstruction of the intersection consisting of a two lane road with a traffic circle, concrete pavers, curbs and gutter, sidewalk, drainage system, removal of existing traffic signal, pavement markings, signage, and associated electrical work, sodding and landscaping. The Village would also like to see installed in the center of the traffic circle a fixed fountain with landscaping and Village branding.

Project Schedule:

Construction of the Traffic Circle located at the intersection of SW 168th Street and SW 87th Avenue, will begin on October 6, 2010 with substantial completion and intersection reopened no later than November 5, 2010.
