

RESOLUTION NO. 02-29

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA URGING APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE PROPOSED NEW CITY OF NORTH DADE, FLORIDA TO SCHEDULE AN ELECTION FOR MUNICIPAL INCORPORATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed new municipality which is currently known as North Dade, Florida is appearing before the Miami-Dade County Commission on December 3, 2002 for approval to hold an election for municipal incorporation in their community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Advisory Committee of North Dade has been meeting continuously over this past year and has complied with all guidelines for municipal incorporation as set forth by the various committees and staff of Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial efforts in the North Dade community to incorporate were begun in 1995 and have been deferred since 1995 to the present time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Palmetto Bay's efforts to incorporate its community had also been deferred since 1996 and subsequently received permission in December, 2001 for the right to hold an election for incorporation in Palmetto Bay in February, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Palmetto Bay supports the efforts of the proposed new City of North Dade to hold an election for municipal incorporation as efforts in that community are being made to bring local government closer to their people.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA** that they urge approval by the Board of County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County, Florida for the proposed new City of North Dade, Florida to schedule an election for municipal incorporation.
