

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-23**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay remains concerned with maintaining the quality of life for residents in our community; and

WHEREAS, the existing inadequate and insufficient transit infrastructure is detrimental to the community; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to improve modes of public transportation to assist our community and the surrounding South Dade area; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay supports the implementation of a transportation plan that assists in relieving the severely congested roadways of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, sustainable growth necessitates convenient public transit options to relieve pressure on the existing roadways throughout our community; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, supports the Year 2025 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and its efforts to advance the US-1/S. Dixie Highway – S.W. 104 Street to Cutler Ridge Premium Transit Project from a Priority IV to a Priority I.

Section 2. The Village of Palmetto Bay additionally supports all efforts to expand the Metrorail line to Cutler Ridge or Florida City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
