

RESOLUTION NO. 03-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO OFFICE FURNITURE; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE VILLAGE HALL FURNISHINGS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM J.C. WHITE QUALITY OFFICE FURNITURE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay adopted Resolution 03-69 wherein the Village amended the lease agreement for office space at Village Hall located at 8950 S.W. 152 Street to include accommodating the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department shall require complete furnishings, including desks, filing cabinets, chairs, and other items in order for the administrative staff, officers and command staff to operate the day-to-day activities of the Department; and

WHEREAS, under State contract, staff met with J.C. White Quality Office Furniture in order to meet the Police Department's needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:



White to furnish the Police Department area of Village Hall in a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00 that is substantially similar in its terms and conditions as the proposal which is annexed to this resolution.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


