RESOLUTION NO. 03-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 03-71 AND REDIRECTING STAFF TO REBID THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SERVICES.

WHEREAS, by resolution no. 03-71, the Village Council approved the selection of a general construction contractor, in part for services to renovate various areas of Coral Reef Park based upon urgencies involved in assuming ownership of the parks as of October 1, 2003; and,

WHEREAS, only one bidder responded to this bid, who did not bid in all areas of construction/repair services; and,

WHEREAS, the urgency of immediate park renovations is past and no immediate urgencies exist for construction services; and

WHEREAS, the Village is desirous of creating and maintaining a list of approved construction specialties to have available for various mechanical, plumbing, electrical and painting service providers for when needs arise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Village Staff is directed to prepare and advertise an RFQ seeking additional bids for specific construction services as previously approved under resolution 03-72.



Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


