

RESOLUTION NO. 04-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A POLICY RELATING TO LIGHT POLE BANNERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village does not currently have a policy relating to the display of light pole banners and the existing County Ordinances concerning the regulation of banners need to be clarified; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a policy relating to light pole banners will establish the intention of the Village to regulate this form of signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following is established as the policy of the Village of Palmetto Bay concerning light pole banners within the Village boundaries:


- The installation of light pole banners shall require written approval of the Village;
- No commercial or for-profit organization banners shall be allowed; to that extent, permission will only be granted to requests for not-for-profit events and/or organizations;
- The maximum duration for light pole banners shall be ⁴⁵~~30~~ days;
- Exceptions to the policy may be granted by the Village Manager with the consent of the Mayor;
- Official Village signs shall be excluded from this policy.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
