

**RESOLUTION NO.** 04-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CODE ENFORCEMENT, APPROVING THE SELECTION OF MT CAUSLEY & CSA SOUTHEAST TO PROVIDE OUTSOURCE CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Palmetto Bay wishes to assume responsibility for Code Enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning, Zoning and Code Enforcement Committee has recommended that outsourcing this function is the best alternative; and

**WHEREAS**, the joint venture of MT Causley & CSA Southeast was selected as the highest ranked firm after a competitive selection process.




