

RESOLUTION NO. 04-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO AD VALOREM TAXES; DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MAXIMUM MILLAGE RATE AND ROLLEBACK RATE AND SETTING THE DATES, TIME AND LOCATION FOR THE FIRST AND SECOND BUDGET HEARINGS FOR FY 2004-05; DIRECTING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO FILE SAID RESOLUTION WITH THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village has received the Certification of Taxable Value from the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser; and,

WHEREAS, the Village is required under State Statute to establish and furnish to the Property Appraiser the proposed maximum millage rate, rollback millage rate and the dates, times and location(s) at which public hearings will be held to consider the FY 2004-05 millage rate and budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposed maximum millage rate for the Village of Palmetto Bay for FY 2003-04 is established at 2.447 mills, which is \$2.447 for each \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Village of Palmetto Bay.

Section 2. The rollback millage rate is 2.2416 mills.

Section 3. The proposed date time and place of the first and second public hearings are scheduled as follows:




Section 4. The Village Clerk is directed to file the original certification of Taxable Value and a certified copy of this resolution to the Property Appraiser.


