RESOLUTION NO. 04-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; APPOINTING MR. RICHARD L. DOODY, ESQ. TO SERVE AS A SPECIAL MASTER FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR; ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF PAY FOR SUCH POSITION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the constitutional powers granted by the Florida constitution, and applicable sections of Chapter 166 of the Florida Statutes, the Mayor and Council adopted Ordinance No. 03-08 on June 2nd, 2003, creating a code enforcement chapter entitled, "Code Enforcement Procedures"; and

WHEREAS, according to the rules and procedures set forth in Ordinance No. 03-08, the Mayor and Council has the power to appoint a Special Master provided that certain qualifications are met; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with its procurement policy, the Village published a Request for Qualifications (RFQ No. 04-004) seeking proposals from qualified individuals or firms to provide Special Master services to the Village; and

WHEREAS, based on the qualifications detailed in the proposal submitted by Mr. Richard L. Doody, Esq., the Village wishes to appoint Mr. Doody to the position of Special Master for code enforcement for a period not to exceed one year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In accordance with the rules and procedures of Ordinance No. 03-08, Mr. Richard L. Doody, Esq. is hereby appointed to serve as the Special Master for the Village of Palmetto Bay for a period not to exceed one year.

Section 2. The rate of pay for such services shall not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) per hour for attendance at hearings and preparation of orders of the special master.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
