A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS ON SW 160TH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY ; APPROVING THE SELECTION OF PETRO HYDRO, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT AT SW 160TH STREET FROM US-1 TO SW 164TH STREET; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPROVE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$124,900 ON A PROJECT THAT WILL SUBSTANTIALLY IMPROVE THE DRAINAGE CONDITIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village selected EAC Consulting, Inc., to design a storm water drainage system that will substantially improve the drainage/flooding condition on SW 160th Street, east of US1 in the Village of Palmetto Bay.

WHEREAS, the Village followed a competitive bid process for SW 160th Street Drainage Improvements Project with the issuance of Invitation to Bid (Bid) #2004-100 ; and

WHEREAS, the Village received bid responses from five respondents, based on the bid package requirements (Section 2.07); and

WHEREAS, the bid analysis conducted by EAC Consulting Inc. and the Village has determined that the submittal received from Petro Hydro, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The following construction company is hereby selected to provide Storm Water Construction Services for the Village of Palmetto Bay.

Pedro-Hydro, Inc.

Section 2: The Village Manager is authorized to contract for Construction Services with Petro Hydro, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$124, 900 on a storm water drainage system on SW 160th Street between US-1 and SW 164th Street consistent with the terms and conditions proposed within Invitation to Bid 2004-100.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
