

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE SOUTH MIAMI-DADE CORRIDOR ALTERNATIVE ANALYSIS; FURTHER APPOINTING TWO INDIVIDUALS TO SERVE AS REPRESENTATIONS' ON THE SOUTH MIAMI-DADE CORRIDOR CITIZEN'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization has begun an Alternative Analysis transit study for the South Miami-Dade Corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the study will involve a Citizen's Advisory Committee(CAC) with members being appointed by municipalities, Community Councils and County Commissioners within the corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the CAC members will provide input to the study team, assist in increasing public participation, and act as liaisons to their respective appointing bodies on project activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Palmetto Bay appoints Mr. Paul Neidhart, Council Member District 2 and Mr. Ron E. Williams, Director of Public Works to serve on the South Miami-Dade Corridor Citizen's Advisory Committee; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Mr. Paul Neidhart, Council Member District 2 and Mr. Ron E. Williams, Director of Public Works are hereby appointed to serve on the South Miami-Dade Corridor Citizen's Advisory Committee as representatives from the Village of Palmetto Bay.

**Section 2:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


