

RESOLUTION NO. 05-31

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA,
SUPPORTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD
IN ITS EFFORTS TO IMPROVE CORAL REEF
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay remains concerned with maintaining the quality of Miami-Dade County Schools within the Village and throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the existing Coral Reef Elementary School is in need of significant improvement; and

WHEREAS, the School Board and School Board Member Evelyn Greer have demonstrated a commitment to developing new levels of cooperation with the Village of Palmetto Bay; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has developed a plan at Coral Reef Elementary that will: a) eliminate portable classrooms; b) replace portables with a permanent concrete structure; and c) provide for additional student stations necessary to reduce class size in order to meet the State class size amendment; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has assured the Village that the new construction is for the purpose of meeting the class size amendment and will not be used for or result in additional students at Coral Reef Elementary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE
COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**




