A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING PET OWNERS' COURTESY TO NEIGHBORS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village does not currently have a clear policy requiring pet owners to be responsible for removing or collecting any waste left by their pets upon the sidewalk or private property throughout the Village; and

WHEREAS, a number of Village residents have voiced their concern regarding pet owners allowing their pets to freely defecate on public and private property; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizenry and visitors of the Village that all precautions be implemented to prevent diseases and disorders related to soil contaminated by pet feces.





Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon enactment.


