

RESOLUTION NO. 06-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, OFFICIALLY REQUESTING MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL AN "ON-DEMAND" CROSSWALK SIGNALIZATION AT SW 82 AVENUE AND SW 163 STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (SPONSORED BY MAYOR EUGENE FLINN)

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay remains concerned with the quality of life and safety of our youth; and

WHEREAS, in order to also foster a culture of walking, the Village is desirous of installing an "on-demand" crosswalk signalization at SW 82 Avenue and SW 163 Street; and

WHEREAS, the installation of this crosswalk will greatly benefit the children and adults of the community by allowing a safe and effective means by which to cross this busy avenue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, officially requests the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department to install an "on-demand" crosswalk signalization at SW 82 Avenue and SW 163 Street

Section 2. The Village Clerk is instructed to forward a certified copy of the Resolution to the Director of Public Works of Miami-Dade County.

Section 3. The Village of Palmetto Bay supports the Miami-Dade County pilot program for solar powered pedestrian flashing beacons if it meets the Village's objective.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


