

**RESOLUTION NO. 06- 118**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO VILLAGE POLICE PROCUREMENT; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR RADAR/SPEED MEASURING DEVICES UNDER MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CONTRACT #6193-1/06 IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$16,900.00 FROM EMERGENCY VEHICLE SUPPLY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay Policing Unit is desirous of procuring Radar/Speed Measuring Devices, in an effort to assist with improving community safety, preventing/monitoring speeding and traffic enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department staff, in accordance with the Village's procurement ordinance, has received authorization to "piggy-back" on the Miami-Dade County Contract #6193-1/06 concerning Radar/Speed Measuring Devices; and

WHEREAS, under the Miami-Dade County Contract, the two Stalker II Moving Radar Units and the eight Stalker II Stationary Radar Units, Remote Controls, Power Cables, Installation kits, Battery Handles, Tuning Forks, Carrying cases, and Chargers, can be procured at a cost of \$16,900.00



Section 1. The Village Manager is authorized to issue a purchase order to procure the two Stalker II Moving Radar Units and the eight Stalker II Stationary Radar Units with requisite accessories at a cost of \$16,900.00 under Miami-Dade County Contract #: 6193-1/06 from Stalker Radar Applied Concepts Inc.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
