

RESOLUTION NO. 06-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, SELECTING THE NAME FOR THE 25 ACRE COMPLEX AT THE SOUTHERNMOST PARK LYING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2005, the Village Council adopted Ordinance 05-12 that established procedures for naming of governmental facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay is desirous of naming the 25 acre parcel of land at 17535 SW 95 Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the 4.5 acres currently known as Perrine Park shall continue to be named Perrine Park; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to give instruction and direction to the Village Manager with regard to carrying out this directive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 25 acre complex at the southernmost park shall be named as follows:

PALMETTO BAY COMMONS

Section 2. The 4.5 acres currently known as Perrine Park shall continue to be named Perrine Park.


Section 3. The Village Manager is instructed to install appropriate markers recognizing the designation of this Park.
