RESOLUTION NO. 06-122

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO NAMING OF THE PARK ADJOINING THE PALMETTO BAY/MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LIBRARY ON OLD CUTLER ROAD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE [Sponsored by Council Person Dr. Ed Feller].

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay, otherwise known as “the village of parks” has made tremendous acquisition of park land over the past three years; and,

WHEREAS, the village has obtained grant funding for a bike path and tot lot for the park adjoining the Palmetto Bay/Miami-Dade County Library; and,

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2005, the Village Council adopted ordinance no 05-12 relating to naming, re-naming and co-designating village facilities, parks, etc.; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the ordinance, the village council may name a site after a person who has made a significant contribution to the community, thereby furthering the Village’s good name and image; and,

WHEREAS, the village may recognize a person, family or corporation, that has provided a contribution through volunteerism, leadership, financial contribution and/or other services considered extraordinary or long term in nature; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council desire to adopt a name for the park adjacent to the Village of Palmetto Bay/Miami-Dade County library on Old Cutler Road and seek to honor a person, family or corporation that has provided a contribution to the village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


