A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; APPROVING THE 2007 STATE LEGISLATIVE AGENDA WHICH SUPPORTS THE PRIORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 2. In the appropriations arena, the Village shall seek to maximize all available appropriation opportunities for Village projects, including but not limited to parks, public works, and community development.


Section 3. In the policy arena, the Village shall seek support for new policy decisions concerning windstorm insurance rates and property tax portability.


Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


