**RESOLUTION NO. 06-48**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE ART IN THE PARK EVENT; PROVIDING FUNDING SUPPORT TO THE CULTURAL COUNCIL FOR THE 2006 EVENT; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ALLOCATE A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000 FOR THE ART IN THE PARK EVENT HELD ANNUALLY AT CORAL REEF PARK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Councilman Feller)

**WHEREAS**, the annual Art in the Park event organized by the Cultural Council has taken place at Coral Reef Park since the Village's incorporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the two-day event, which features a number of juried artists, has been extremely successful and has been welcomed by all village residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cultural Council has requested a partnership with the village to fund the event; and,

**WHEREAS**, last year, the Cultural Council received a total of \$46,500 in revenues but spent \$52,259 on the event, leaving a deficit of \$5,759; and,

**WHEREAS**, the village feels this is an important and desirable event to the Palmetto Bay community; and,

**WHEREAS**, the village wishes to support the 2006 event by providing funding assistance in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 in the form of in-kind services and costs defrayals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** The Village Council approves funding assistance to the Cultural Council for the 2006 Art in the Park event held at Coral Reef Park.

**Section 2:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to allocate an amount not to exceed \$6,000 for the 2006 Art in the Park event in the form of in-kind services provided by the Village and costs defrayals.


