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RESOLUTION NO. 06-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE VILLAGE STREET SIGNAGE MASTER PLAN; FURTHER ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE FINAL STREET SIGNAGE DESIGN CONCEPT; AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO RELEASE BID SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF MAJOR AND MINOR STREET SIGNAGE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is currently responsible for the design, fabrication, maintenance and installation of signage within the boundaries of Palmetto Bay

WHEREAS, there are no consistent standards for signage on the streets of Palmetto Bay that specifically project a positive image of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay entered into a contract with the Corradino Group to develop street signage standards that provide consistency throughout the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village will use this final sign concept and specification as a guide to bid on the fabrication and installation of major and minor street signs; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO, BAY FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida accepts the final design concept and specifications for street signage and authorizes its implementation as a guide to bid for the Corradino Group with the bidding process required for the selection of competent fabricators/ contractors to manufacture and install street signs within the Village.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
