A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO PARKS AND RECREATION; SELECTING A NEW NAME FOR PALMETTO BAY COMMONS; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay, a.k.a. the "Village of Parks," is extremely proud of all of our park initiatives; and

WHEREAS, our southernmost park will soon be transformed from a five-acre park facility in desperate need of renovation to a state-of-the-art, 25-acre facility that will include walking paths, open green space, softball fields, a large Boundless Playground, a skate pavilion, picnic pavilions and much more; and

WHEREAS, there has been continued discussion as to the best name for the park and that is the purpose of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, it shall be noted that the original core area will continue to be called Perrine Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.      Rename Palmetto Bay Commons Palmetto Bay Park

Section 2.      Install appropriate signage.

Section 3.      This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
